STARTALK Year-Round Chinese Program for Iowa High School Students (2022-23)

The STARTALK year-round program is a three-semester plus one summer day-camp Chinese Learning Program specially designed for IOWA junior high and high school students of Grades 8-11 who wish to learn Chinese.

Participants will earn 11 University of Iowa credits upon successful completion of the program. The STARTALK program is funded by a National Security Agency Grant, designated to promote critical language education in the U.S. Selected participants will receive a scholarship of approximately \$6,800 to cover all learning costs, including tuition, learning materials, lunches during the summer camp, cultural activities, workshops, and field trips. Because it is a day program, no housing accommodation will be provided. The program will admit 20 students.
